Every member of the David Scott School has rights and responsibilities. As a student you have the right to:

- be provided with wellbeing support to help achieve your goals;
- be involved in decisions the David Scott School makes to support you;
- your personal information being kept private and confidential, unless a Release of Information Form has been signed;
- provide feedback on any issue at any time;

As a student it is your responsibility to:

1. Show care and respect for all people by:

- refraining from actions and behaviour that constitutes bullying, harassment, discrimination or vilification in any form including verbal, physical or cyber, because of gender, disability, race, culture, religion, or sexual orientation
- behaving in a manner that does not endanger the health, safety and wellbeing of yourself or others and exercises self-discipline at all times
- dressing appropriately and with due regard for health, hygiene and safety
- follow all responsible instructions from any staff member

2. Show a positive attitude to learning by:

- Respecting the right of all students to learn and for their teachers to teach
- refraining from behaviour which would interrupt the work of any class or the learning opportunities of other students
- completing work set by your teacher to the best of your ability and to utilise when needed, educational and wellbeing support;

3. Contribute to a productive working environment by:

- being punctual and attending all classes; including excursions
- remaining at school unless otherwise approved by the school Principal
- following all health and safety rules and procedures within the school and other locations you may visit as a student
- respecting school property and the property of other students, staff, visitors/contractors
